### Eagle Count Results...

The Eagle Count was held on Saturday, January 29, 2000. The weather was cold and overcast with snow starting around 11:00 AM for the southern teams and hitting the Chillicothe area around 12:00 PM which hampered sightings. The river was frozen with only the channel open. Along the way, we enjoyed watching the eagles fish as the barges came through.

We had four land teams and one boat team with a total of 16 observers. We had no observers at the roost site before dawn this year. The northwest team also saw one immature Golden Eagle. The one boat team counted eagles from Pekin down to Banner, Illinois Copperas Creek landing. Two new nest sites were spotted, one north of Pekin on the east side of the river and one on the west side of the river south of Pekin.

Lists were compared for duplicate sightings. Due to the boat in the southern areas, Bert Princen compared the southeast and southwest data and concluded that 48 of the 228 eagles seen by the boat were duplicates of those counted by the land teams. All duplicates were subtracted.

We are very thrilled and encouraged by the count this year. Even if we didn't have the fortune of the men in the boat assisting with the count, we would have still seen a record 465 eagles. Thanks for all who participated this year!

### Birdathon, Saturday, May 13

Several teams will be scouring central Illinois in an all out effort to see as many species as possible. This is an annual fundraiser for our local club. We challenge each member to take a pledge from a friend or fellow employee. We will also be donating 25% of the proceeds to the Partners in Flight Project—an international organization dedicated to the protection of neotropical migrating bird species.

We hope to see a total of 140 species between the two teams on this year's birdathon. The competition is getting pretty fierce! To make your pledge, fill out the enclosed form and mail it to Greet Princen.
